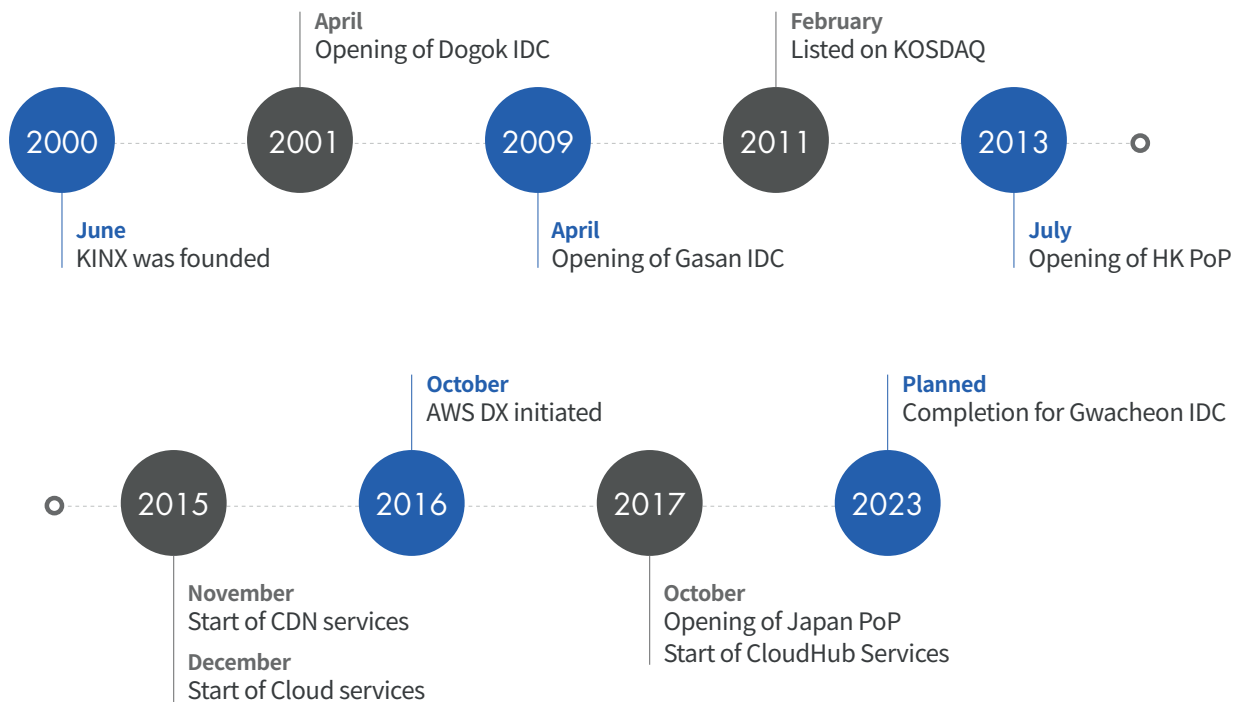

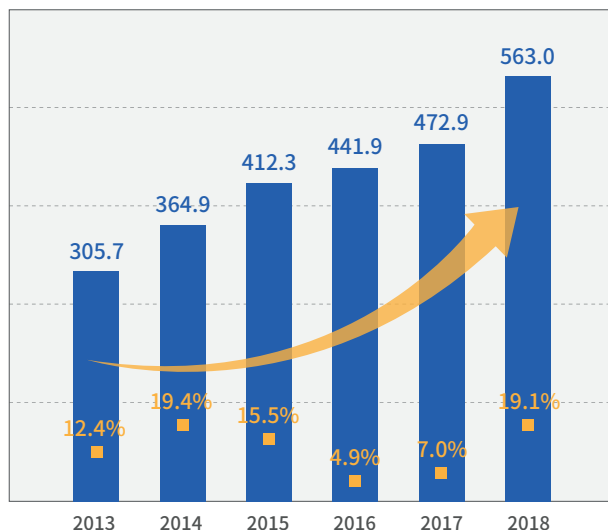

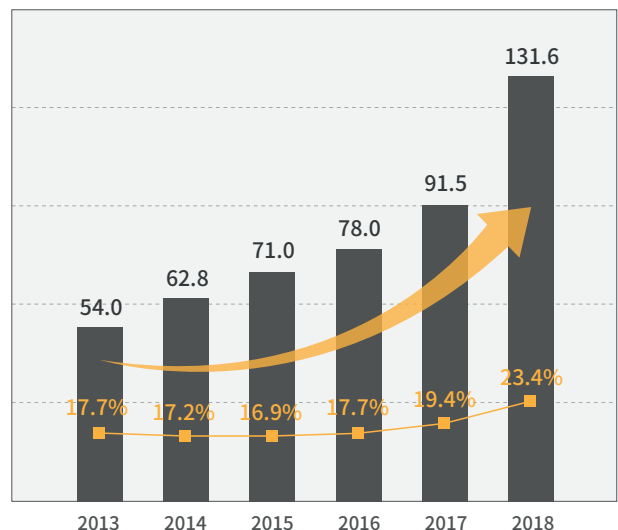
Business Performance

Revenue, Revenue Growth Rate

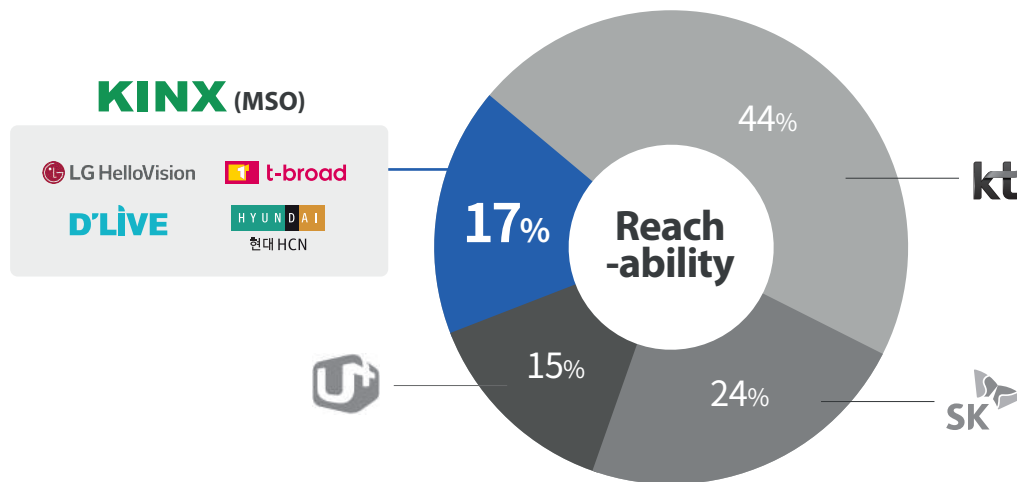


Operating profit, Operating Margin

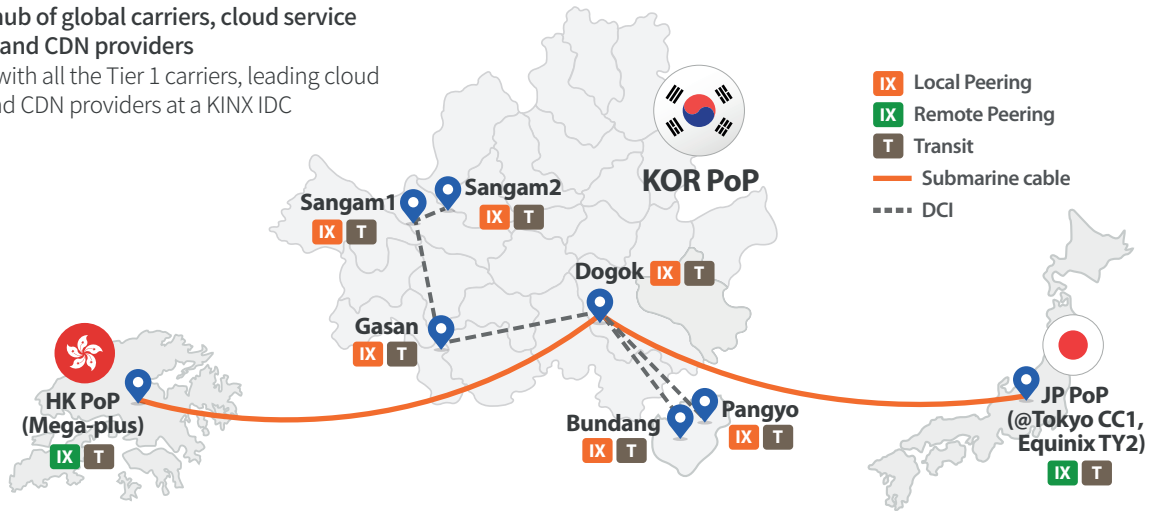

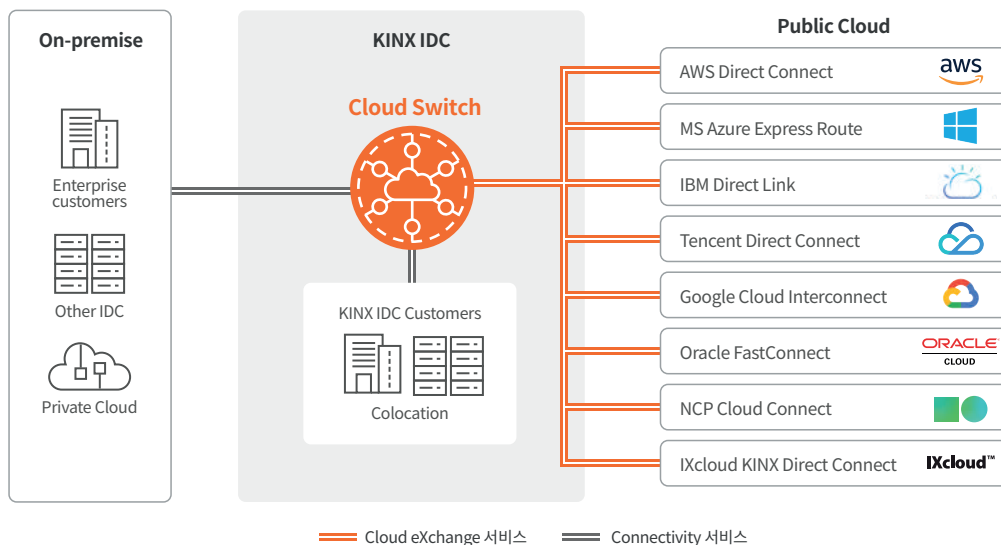
